What we have done...

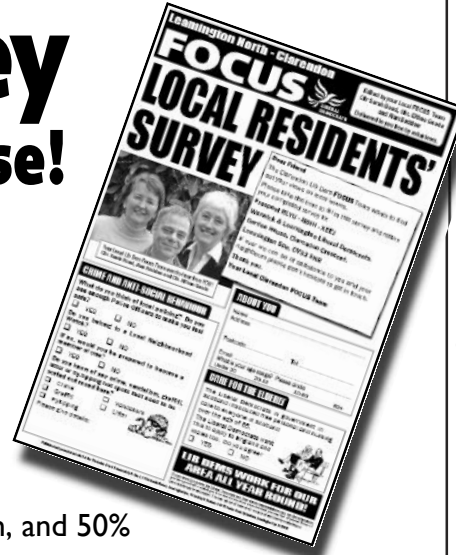
We have taken up many of the points you have raised with us and taken the following action:

- ✓ passed on the names and addresses of those wishing to join Neighbourhood Watch.
- ✓ contacted the Neighbourhood Policing Teams regarding vandalism and other acts of anti-social behaviour.
- ✓ asked the County Council to deal with damaged roads and pavements.
- ✓ reported areas where there is graffiti to the District Council and other land owners, and are investigating the use of the graffiti busting machine.
- ✓ asked for extra patrols by the dog warden in areas where dog fouling is an issue.
- ✓ passed on your comments about the bus services and the new bus passes.

Changes to Parking Proposals

Thank you to all of you who got in touch with your views on the changes to parking in Leamington.

As a result of comments received from you we have managed to get changes made to the scheme in Augusta Place, Beauchamp Avenue, Clarendon Street, Oxford Street, and Regent Grove. (other plans were also changed outside Clarendon Ward).

The plans were voted on at the Area Committee on January 30th.

Parade Paving Problems

Councillors Sarah Boad and Eithne Goode walked both sides of the Parade with County Council officers earlier this month to look at the state of the new paving.

Cllr Sarah Boad commented 'It is very easy to see where cars and lorries have been parking on the pavements as that is where the cracked slabs are, drivers must stop doing this or the damage will get worse'.

Plans are in place to repair damage, including the area near the Pump Rooms which flooded at the beginning of January.
