New Cycleway Means Safer Route to School.

The children of Leamington are soon to have a safe cycleway linking the town with north Leamington.

Your Liberal Democrat Councillors supported this proposal which will benefit children attending schools in the area. Cycling is a healthy, economical and pollution-free way to travel to school.

The route will run along Binswood Avenue and Lillington Road to the proposed new location of North Leamington School at Manor Hall.

The zebra crossing on Kenilworth Road will become one of four special toucan crossings along the route designed especially for cyclists.

A key focus of the Cycling Strategy is to continue to develop cycle route networks in the main county towns of Leamington Spa, Warwick, Rugby, Nuneaton and Stratford-upon-Avon. We also work with Sustrans to develop the National Cycle Network within Warwickshire.
