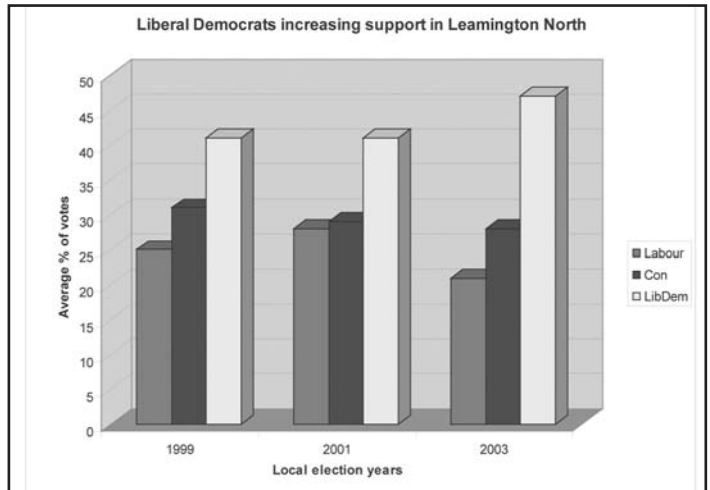
LIB DEM SUPPORT GROWING ... now at 46%

As can be seen from the graph, Liberal Democrat support in Leamington North has grown to 46% whilst both Conservative and Labour support is in decline. Liberal Democrats currently have 5 out of 7 District and Town Councillors for the area and 2 of the 3 current County Councillors.

New County Ward Boundaries

All change for 2005

It's "all change" for the County Council election on 5th May. Say "Goodbye" to Clarendon, Crown and Manor Divisions and say "Hello" to the new Leamington North Division which will consist of approximately 14 thousand electors!

The major change is that the new division of Leamington North will elect two County Councillors (instead of one each for the three wards.) This is unusual at County level but is quite usual at District and Town levels where there will be no change to existing wards.

Why?

The reason for this change is that the County boundaries have been reviewed by the Boundary Commission to try to ensure that each County Councillor across Warwickshire represents a similar number of electors. Both Clarendon and Crown were deemed to be over-represented and have now been merged with Manor. As the new Division of Leamington North is much larger than other divisions, it will be represented by two County Councillors.
