### Wathen Road Area



In a previous edition of FOCUS, **Cllr Eithne Goode** told you that when she had been visiting someone in the Wathen Road area, she noticed how bad the pavements were. There has been a lot of patching and also general deterioration, leaving them in an unstable and potentially dangerous condition. Eithne asked for the pavements in **Wathen Road, Waller Street, Granville Street and Brownlow Street** to be resurfaced. The pavements have now been marked-up for re-surfacing and the work will be carried out soon.

### Dereham Court and Denville Road

**Cllr Roger Copping** has asked for double yellow lines to be installed at the entrance to Dereham Court and Denville Drive. At the moment, because of parked cars, large vehicles sometimes drive over the pavement and gardens, causing damage as they do.
