Sadly, this was overruled by the Planning Committee on advice from the Environment Agency. Good flood defences are vital for this development to prevent residents being flooded in the future."

Road Repairs Ahead

Sidney Tyrrell, who is standing for the District Council, is delighted that the County Council have agreed to include a number of Milverton pavements and roads in next year's maintenance programme.

She said, "Amongst the roads to be re-surfaced and have new pavement toppings will be those on the Avonside estate, Archery Road and Victoria Street and Road. The top of Guys Cliffe Avenue, Coniston Road and Acacia Road will also be repaired. Pavements will be re-surfaced in Strathearn Road, Fairlawn Close and Church Hill."
