Car Parking Shock Increase in April from 20p to 40p

There is considerable shock and anger at the proposed doubling to 40p from 20p for half an hour's on-street parking by the Conservative County Council Council. Leamington already provides over £ 300,000 profit each year from its on-street car parking for the County Council.

Councillor David Greenwood said, "I am especially worried by the increased cost of the half hour charge from 20p to 40p and the effect that will have on the already hard-hit shops in the town."

David went on to point out, "The County Council has refused to even discuss the charges with the Town Council, despite the massive profits that the the County Council gets from the town. We will continue to press for a fairer deal for Leamington."

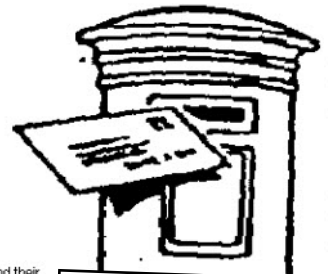
